

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF GALWAY CAVENDISH & HARVEY**

BY-LAW NUMBER 2005-122

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR REGULATING THE DISPOSAL
OF CERTAIN GARBAGE AND REFUSE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF GALWAY-
CAVENDISH AND HARVEY AND TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF OTHER AREAS
FOR THE DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE.

WHEREAS Section 189 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended give lower tier municipalities the power for waste management;

AND WHEREAS the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P13, as amended provides that councils may pass Bylaws for prohibiting, regulating and inspecting the use of land or structures within the Township or a defined area or areas;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to prohibit the use of lands for the purpose of dumping and disposing of garbage, refuse or domestic or industrial waste of any kind except the land hereinafter identified for such purposes;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey deems it advisable to establish a policy for the disposal of certain garbage and other refuse from within the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED that the Council of the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey hereby enacts as follows:

1. The following lands shall be established as Waste Disposal Sites and no other lands in the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey shall be used for this purpose:
 - 1.1 Buckhorn W.S.D. located at Part Lot 11, Concession 6, County Road 36, east of Buckhorn, Ontario.
 - 1.2 North W.D.S. located at Part Lot 17, Concession 19, County Road 36, east of Bobcaygeon, Ontario.
 - 1.3 Cavendish W.D.S. located at Part Lot 15, Concession 3, County Road 507, north of Mississauga Landing.
 - 1.4 Crystal Lake Road W.D.S. located at Part Lot 10, Concession 11, Crystal Lake Road.
2. Definitions:
 - 2.1 "Garbage and Refuse" shall mean discarded material and goods incidental to the operation of households, business establishments and public places.
 - 2.2 "Building Material" shall mean any discarded substance, matter, material, equipment or scrap incidental to the construction or erection of buildings.
 - 2.3 "Industrial waste" shall mean the residue from any manufacturing, refining, processing or other operation
 - 2.4 "Domestic waste" means any substance, matter, material, equipment or scrap or any apparently abandoned article or thing lying in an area which is not reasonably related to the use or uses permitted by the Township

Zoning Bylaw, or creates a condition likely to cause a fire, accident or danger the health.

- 2.5 “Domestic or industrial waste” shall include highly flammable materials, explosives, drugs, dangerous chemicals, dead animals or motor vehicles.
3. No person shall use any land or structure or being the owner or lessee or occupant thereof, permit the use of any land or structures within the limits of the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey for the purpose of dumping or disposing of garbage or refuse or domestic or industrial waste of any kind, except in those lands of the Township established in clause 1 of this Bylaw.
 4. No person shall use any land or structures or being the owner or lessee or occupant thereof, permit the use of any land or structures within the limits of the township for storing used motor vehicles for the purpose of wrecking or dismantling or salvaging parts whether for sale or other disposal, except in accordance with the provisions of the Township Zoning Bylaw as amended.
 5. No person shall dispose of any sewage, animal or human waste within the Waste Disposal sites.
 6. Abandoned motored vehicles, dead animals, agricultural wastes, inert fill, and residue from septic tanks shall not be disposed of in the landfill site.
 7. All paper shall be suitably wrapped or tied to prevent scattering, before being deposited in the designated containers, in the Waste Disposal Sites.
 8.
 - (a) The use of the Waste Disposal Sites shall be limited to those times when the site is open and authorization to use the sites at other times may be granted only by the Council of the Township. The Council, by resolution duly noted in the minutes of a Council meeting may, with reasonable notice close any or all Waste Disposal Sites from time to time or for periods of time as required.
 - (b) No person shall deposit any garbage, refuse, domestic or industrial waste at any Waste Disposal Site during those times when such site is closed to the public unless authorization to do so by the Council of the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey.
 9. All persons using the landfill sites will be required to present a valid landfill site card for the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey before entering the landfill site and must provide additional identification if requested by the attendant, a member of Council, or any other person appointed by Council, or be refused entry to the landfill site.
 10. Hazardous waste that requires special precaution in its storage, collection, transportation, treatment or disposal to prevent damages to persons or property, shall not be disposed of in any landfill site unless prior approval is received from the Ministry of the Environment and the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey Council.
 11. Any materials being conveyed to the landfill sites must be covered in such a manner so not to allow it to blow with the wind or leave deposits along the roads. Failure to transport material in said manner will result in refusal of entry to the landfill site.
 12. Tipping fees charged under this by-law shall be according to Schedule “A” and attached hereto and shall form part of this by-law. All tipping fees shall be paid prior to dumping, save and except for contractors and businesses who may, with prior arrangements, be invoiced for the materials deposited. Failure to pay the invoice upon receipt shall negate any prior arrangements for invoicing.

13. The council of the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey shall appoint attendants as required to supervise the operation and use of the landfill sites. The decision of the attendant is final with respect to the use of the landfill sites by the public.
14. All builders, roofers, contractors or other tradespeople doing work in the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey and wishing to use the landfill sites must complete the required form at the municipal office, provide proof that the work is being done for a township property owner, and have said form signed by a municipal official. This form must be left with the landfill site attendant.
15. There shall be no exception for building materials with respect to the cost of dumping.
16. Scavenging or salvaging is strictly prohibited by all persons, save and except for the attendant, shall be deemed a breach of this law. Waste disposal items become the property of the municipality.
17. The discharging of firearms is prohibited within the landfill sites.
18. Any Provincial Offences Officers appointed by the Council of the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey shall have full authority for the interpretation and enforcement of the provisions of this by-law.
19.
 - (a) All persons using the Waste Disposal Sites shall be required to place different types of garbage and refuse in the specified containers as required. Recycling must be carried out in accordance with the County of Peterborough Mandatory Recycling By-law.
 - (b) All waste, garbage and refuse brought to any Waste Disposal Site that is contained in any bag or container, every such bag or container shall be made of a clear or transparent material so as to allow the contents of such bag or container to be visible.
20. Any person, whether acting personally or through any agent, representative, or employee and any agent, representative or employee, who contravenes any part or provision of this by-law, is guilty of an offence and upon conviction, shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate, a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$300.00 and such penalty shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
21. That a waste disposal card with two passes will be issued to ratepayers with the interim tax bill for each property roll number.
22. If original is lost an additional card, containing two passes will be provided to the property owner free of charge per calendar year.
23. That any additional replacement or additional cards will be issued to the property owner for a fee of \$25.00 **per waste disposal pass**, being \$50.00 for a complete card with two passes.
24. That once the Deed for a new property owner has been received that a card with two landfill passes will be issued free of charge to the new property owner.

25. Waste Disposal sites shall be operated in accordance with the requirements of the Ministry of the Environment and Ministry of Natural Resources.
26. In the event of default by any person in carrying out the requirements of this Bylaw, or any notice given as provided herein, the Council of the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey may have such things done and any monies expended by the Corporation in doing so may be recovered by an action or in a like manner as Municipal Taxes.
27. That By-Law No. B98-58 of the Township of Galway-Cavendish and Harvey is hereby repealed

Tipping Fees
Schedule "A" to By-law B2005-122

Residential Household Waste: No Tipping Fees, No Bag Limit

Tipping fees will be applied to materials brought to the waste site as follows:

MISCELLANEOUS METALS & NON - HOUSEHOLD WASTE

- \$25.00 per box trailer or pickup approximately 2 cubic yards -
OVERSIZED additional cost \$15.00 per cubic yard.
- \$115.00 per dump truck, trailer, box (maximum 8 cubic yards) -
OVERSIZED additional cost \$15.00 per cubic yard.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION MATERIALS

Maximum 2 ½ Yards

- \$50.00 per box trailer or pickup (approximately 2 cubic yards)
- \$25.00 per cubic yard
- **Oversized** All construction and demolition materials over and above 2 cubic yards are to be taken to the Peterborough County/City Landfill Site and subject to the Peterborough County/City Landfill site tipping fees.
Peterborough County/City Landfill Site 1260 Bensfort Road, Peterborough

COMMERCIAL/BRUSH

- \$15.00 per pickup truck
- \$25.00 for oversize load
- \$50.00 for dump truck

APPLIANCES

Maximum 2 appliances

- \$10.00 per item, includes wood stoves, furnaces and hot water tanks etc.
(Appliances must have Freon removed and accompanied by a certificate)

FURNITURE

- \$10.00 per item, includes double size and larger mattresses, box springs and couches.

ALL OTHER FURNITURE

- \$5.00 per item includes single and smaller mattresses and box springs, chairs, rolls of carpet etc.

TIRES

- \$5.00 per up to 17 inches
- \$15.00 per heavy equipment

Maximum of 4 tires

BOATS

- \$25.00 up to 10 feet
- \$5.00 per additional foot, 5 (five) foot limit

The Waste Site Attendant reserves the right to charge an appropriate fee for any item not listed above under the authorization of the Supervisor.
